Pastoral Council: Main points from meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council held during the past week:

1. As Covid continues in our community: (A) No change in method of collecting the Offertory donations at the Masses. Again many thanks for your continued support. (B) Holy water fonts to remain empty of water for the moment. (Of course we can bless ourselves without using holy water on entering the church.)
2. It was felt that one Sunday each month should be designated as a 'Children's Mass. Parents will be encouraged to bring their children, no matter how young, to Mass.
3. The Blessing of Toddlers should be revived. To take place towards end of September or early October. This used to be a lovely celebration pre-covid.
4. As 15th August this year falls on Monday it was decided to have one Mass, 11.00 a.m. in St. Michael's, for the whole parish on that day.
5. There was a discussion on the Synodal Pathway taking place in our Diocese and throughout the country. People are encouraged to read the results of the various submissions and meetings which is available on achonrydiocese.org. We also had a brief discussion on the upcoming shortage of priests in our Diocese and how it will impinge on our parishes and on the number of Masses.
6. Gratitude was expressed to our two retiring School Principals, Ms. Eileen O'Brien and Mr. John McHugh and every good wish and blessings to the two new Principals, Mr. Daire McManamon and Mr. John McEvelly.
